## Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy 2020 Alumni Achievement Award

The year 2020 marks the 24th anniversary of the Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy Alumni Achievement Awards. The PT and OT Alumni Achievement Awards, first awarded in June 1996, acknowledge graduates who have made exceptional contributions as members of the Physical Therapy or Occupational Therapy professions. Alumni or members of the public may nominate a University of Toronto graduate in Physical Therapy or Occupational Therapy for this award. Each year, one alumnus from Physical Therapy and one alumnus from Occupational Therapy receive the award in the spring at the Alumni Reunion. We encourage all alumni or members of the public to consider nominating University of Toronto graduates in Physical Therapy and/or Occupational Therapy for these distinguished awards. The achievements of the alumnus should demonstrate the qualitative impact for the health and well-being of individuals, organizations and/or society. The nominations must include evidence of outstanding achievements and contributions to the professions of Physical Therapy and/or Occupational Therapy in three or more of the six categories.

- leadership in strategic planning activities that significantly contribute to the success of professional endeavors
- leadership roles within PT/OT professional associations
- leadership that influences government activities or related policy initiatives
- development of new business initiatives that enhance PT/OT practice

### **5. Political Influence and Advocacy carried out to benefit**

- a specific client group
- the PT and/or OT professions
- the PT and/or OT associations
- issues relative to healthcare delivery
- government activities or initiatives related to OT/PT or Rehabilitation
- the health and well-being of individuals, groups, organizations and/or society
